CONSOLIDATION ORDER 2017 (VARIOUS ROADS IN THE BOROUGH OF HINCKLEY
& BOSWORTH) (AMENDMENT 11) ORDER 201

THE LEICESTERSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL hereby gives notice that it proposes to make an Order under Sections 1, 2, 4, 5, 32, 35, 45, 46, 47, 49 and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (“the Act”), and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, the effect of which will be:

1. To impose a Mandatory School Keep Clear Monday – Friday 8am – 4pm on part of Sketchley Road, Burbage, Glebe Road, Groby, Ashford Road, London Road, Priory Walk and Wykin Road, Hinckley, Back Lane & Station Road, Market Bosworth, Barton Road, Barlestone, High Street & Sherwood Road, Stoke Golding and Townend Road, Barwell

A copy of the proposed Order, together with plans illustrating the proposals and an explanatory statement giving the Council's reasons for proposing to make the Order may be inspected during normal office hours at my offices, Room 200, County Hall, Glenfield, Leicester LE3 8RA, and at the offices of Hinckley & Bosworth Borough Council, Hinckley Hub, Rugby Road, Hinckley LE10 0FR, and on the notice boards of the various Parish Councils.
