

THE LEICESTERSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL  
(VARIOUS ROADS IN THE PARISHES OF MARKET BOSWORTH AND SHEEPY IN THE  
BOROUGH OF HINCKLEY AND BOSWORTH) (IMPOSITION OF A 40 MPH AND 50 MPH  
SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 201

THE LEICESTERSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL hereby gives notice that it proposes to make an Order under Sections 5 and 84 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (“the Act”), and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, the effect of which will be:

1. To impose a 40mph speed limit on parts of Bosworth Road, Sheepy and Wellsborough Road, Market Bosworth
2. To impose a 50mph speed limit on parts of Wellsborough Road and Carlton Road, Market Bosworth
